

PRESENT DISTRICT ORGANIZATION

Mariposa County has within or overlapping its boundaries twenty-five elementary districts, two joint elementary districts and one high school district. The Marced Falls Joint Elementary District is under the jurisdiction of Merced County, the Buck Meadows Joint Elementary District, joint with Tuolumne County, is under Mariposa County jurisdiction. The high school district encompasses the entire County.

The 26 elementary districts may be grouped as follows:

Six - Bagby, Bull Creek, Green Mountain, Granite Springs, Lewis and Oakvale - are suspended;

One - Ben Hur - with but two pupils enrolled sends them under contract to Mariposa;

Eleven - Bear Valley, Buck Meadows, Jt., Chowchilla, Colorado, Coulterville, Exchequer, Hornitos, Oak Grove, Princeton, Quartzburg, and Wawona - support one-teacher schools;

Five - Bear Creek, Cathey's Valley, El Portal, Mt. Buckingham, and Sebastopol - support two-teacher schools;

Two - Oak Grove and Greeley - support one-teacher schools, but have within their boundaries emergency schools at Indian Peak and Servaes Sawmill respectively. Both of these emergency schools are supported from the County School Service Fund;

Yosemite - supports a three-teacher school, and

Mariposa - supports a four-teacher school with a fifth teacher having been added to the staff in January 1948 with the aid of the County School Service Fund.
